Major project	140 marks
CAD/CAM exercise	30 marks
Production game	30 marks
Visits programme	40 marks
9 examined modules	60 marks each
1 module assessed by coursework	60 marks

Students are expected to undertake all the coursework as specified above. No allowance will be made for absence unless it is due to illness or other grave cause, and will be made then only if the reasons are presented in writing by the student's Tutor and are found to be acceptable by the Head of Department. Work submitted for marking must be that of the student who submits it.
